COUNTY COUNCIL OF MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA

FISCAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-7C

WHEREAS, on or about October 13, 2020, the Madison County Council (the “Council”) adopted the 2021 County budget, which included rates and wages payable to County employees during 2021 (the “2021 Salary Ordinance”); and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend the 2021 Salary Ordinance to provide extra pay (the “Hazard Pay”) for employees of the County whose job duties during 2020 required them to (1) have direct contact with the public in order to perform the essential function of the job, (2) report for work at their primary work location, and (3) perform hazardous duty or work involving physical hardship as it related to the Covid-19 pandemic.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Madison County Council, as follows:

1. County employees who meet the above criteria are eligible for Hazard Pay, payable in 2021, according to the schedules attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
2. Final eligibility for Hazard Pay shall be determined by the Council in conjunction with the heads of each Department.
3. Eligible county employees must have been continually employed from March 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 to be eligible for the entire amount of Hazard Pay.
4. Eligible county employees who were not continually employed for the entire period shall be eligible to a pro-rata amount of Hazard Pay.
5. County employees whose employment was terminated prior to December 31, 2020 are not eligible for Hazard Pay.
6. County employees who retired with a pension prior to December 31, 2020 are eligible for a pro-rata amount of Hazard Pay.
7. Hazard Pay payments shall be subject to appropriation of available funds by the Council.
8. The amendments as set forth above supersede any inconsistent provisions in the 2021 Salary Ordinance. All other portions of the 2021 Salary Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
9. This Amendment shall take place immediately upon passage.
