

ORDINANCE NO: 2024-BC-O-06

**ORDINANCE OF THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON ALL WIND ENERGY SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Commissioners has adopted, pursuant to Indiana Code §36-7-4-602, a zoning ordinance specializing in permitted uses, special uses, development uses and other requirements concerning various land use districts in Madison County; and,

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2024, the Madison County Plan Commission did unanimously forward a favorable recommendation for the adoption of an Ordinance Establishing a Moratorium on all Windfarm Systems in the unincorporated boundaries of Madison County; and,

WHEREAS, after discussions with the Madison County Planning Staff, as well as a review of trends in the industry, the Madison County Board of Commissioners deem it necessary to re-consider and potentially re-draft Madison County's Wind Systems Ordinance, requiring moratorium on the current portion of the Ordinance.



A moratorium is hereby placed on all petitions for Windfarm Energy Systems within Madison County, Indiana.


This Ordinance is effective as of the 19th day of March, 2024.
