

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-BC-O- 2

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WEIGHT LIMITS
IN AND AROUND THE AREA OF COUNTY ROAD 1050 SOUTH
IN UNINCORPORATED MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Commissioners have received information regarding the operation of certain triaxle trailers in the area of County Road 1050 South between State Road 9 and CR 575 West, in southern Madison County; and,

WHEREAS, the County, through its personnel and elected officials has investigated the layout of the road in this area as it relates to the operation of triaxle trailers; and,

WHEREAS, based upon the investigation, the Board of Commissioners believe there is actual or threatened injury to persons or property by permitting the operation of certain triaxle trailers in the area; and,

WHEREAS, there is urgent necessity requiring the immediate effectiveness of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Madison County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. There is hereby established a 30-ton weight limit for all triaxle trailers and all other commercial vehicular traffic, with the exception of agricultural traffic, on County Road 1050 South between State Road 9 and CR 575 West.
2. That there is an urgent necessity requiring the immediate effectiveness of this Ordinance.
3. Violation of this Ordinance is subject to a minimum fine of \$1,000.00 per occurrence and a maximum of \$2,500.00 per occurrence.

This policy is effective immediately upon acceptance by the Madison County Board of Commissioners.
