

ORDINANCE 2022-BC-O- 12

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MADISON COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULATING THE USAGE OF
ALL COUNTY OWNED PARKING SPACES**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Commissioners (hereafter "Commissioners"), as the executive of Madison County, retain the authority to regulate parking in county owned parking lots and parking spaces ("County Parking"); and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have previously regulated County Parking by and through Ordinance Nos. 82-BC-03, 1998-BC-O-06, 2004-BC-O-01; 2022-BC-O-05; and,

WHEREAS, after reviewing parking patterns and receiving information from county officials, that county parking lots are frequently being utilized by automobiles lacking required parking passes, the Madison County Board of Commissioners deem it necessary to set a penalty for unauthorized use of County Parking lot spaces.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that for all Madison County Parking Lots, the penalty for unauthorized use of these lots shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00), the second offense of this Ordinance shall be Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), and all subsequent offenses of this Ordinance shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00); and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Madison County Sheriff and his agents are authorized to enforce this Ordinance by issuing citations as described herein, and to cause to have any vehicles parked in violation of this Ordinance towed and stored at the vehicle's owner's or operator's expense.

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after publication as required by Indiana law.


