

**ORDINANCE AMENDING
SPEED LIMIT FOR COUNTY ROAD 800 SOUTH
IN UNINCORPORATED MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Indiana, is the governing body for Madison County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County, Indiana, is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of all county roads; and,

WHEREAS, for purposes of enhancing safety on the roadways and in the public interest, the Board of Commissioners of Madison County has found it necessary amend Ordinance #2021-BC-O-16, to increase the 30-mph speed limit to 45 mph on County Road 800 South, from 375 feet east of State Road 13, to 2,700 feet west of County Road 650 West, in unincorporated Madison County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Madison County Board of Commissioners that the County Highway Supervisor and/or the County Engineer shall be authorized to install and maintain speed limit signs prohibiting the operation of any motor vehicle along certain public roadways described herein in excess of the maximum speed limit set forth below:

Street/Road	Location	Speed Limit
CR 800 South	375 feet East of State Road 13 to 2,700 feet West of CR 650 West	45 mph

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that upon finding of a violation of this Ordinance, a penalty shall be assessed in accordance with Indiana Code.

This Ordinance amends, supersedes, repeals and replaces any and all existing Ordinances which imposed speed limits on the subject roadway.

This policy is effective immediately upon acceptance by the Madison County Board of Commissioners.


