

RESOLUTION 2024-BC-R-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ESTABLISHING A HOLIDAY FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES
WHO WORKED ON APRIL 8, 2024**

WHEREAS, due to a total solar eclipse in Madison County, the Madison County Government Center and some other county properties were closed on April 8, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, owing to these closures, employees of the county deemed “non-essential” did not work on April 8, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, many county employees deemed “essential” did work on April 8, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, in the order of fairness and in appreciation to those essential county employees who worked on April 8, 2024, the Madison County Board of Commissioners deems it necessary to establish a holiday for those employees.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an extra paid holiday is hereby established in the calendar year 2024 for Madison County employees, which holiday may only be utilized under the following conditions:

1. The employee must have been required to work by a Madison County officer, agent, or other department on April 8, 2024.
2. The extra holiday may only be utilized from April 9, 2024 - May 31, 2024.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event an eligible employee does not utilize the extra holiday described herein by May 31, 2024, they shall waive their right to it.
